### **Attainment Summary**

A new teacher assessment framework was first used in schools in Jersey in the 2015/2016 academic year, following the introduction of the 2014 Jersey Curriculum. Under the new assessment framework, the terms 'Emerging', 'Developing' and 'Secure' are used to show the extent to which a pupil has understood and can apply what they have been taught at the end of each academic year, for pupils from Year 1 to Year 6. For most pupils, the assessment judgements will correspond with the curriculum objectives for the chronological year group that they are in. For example, a pupil in Year2 may be assessed as 2 Emerging, 2 Developing or 2Secure. Pupils assessed against curriculum objectives below their chronological year group are likely to have identified Special Educational Needs (SEN), or other significant barrier(s) to learning.

## End of Key Stage One Attainment Data (Year 2)

Reading

95% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS1. This compares to 86% across all mainstream Government schools.

Writing

85% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS1. This compares to 82% across all mainstream Government schools.

Mathematics

93% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS1. This compares to 84% across all mainstream Government schools.

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## End of Key Stage Two Attainment Data (Year 6)

Reading

100% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 83% across all schools. *Writing* 

96% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 83% across all schools. *Mathematics* 

98% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Developing or above within their year group at the end of KS2. This compares to 82% across all schools.

## End of Foundation Stage Attainment Data

Reading

74% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Early Learning Goal (ELG) achieved within their year group at the end of Reception, compared to 72% across all mainstream Government schools . 35% were exceeding ELG, compared to 21% across all mainstream Government schools. *Writing* 

74% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Early Learning Goal (ELG) achieved within their year group at the end of Reception compared to 65% across all mainstream Government schools . 26% were exceeding ELG, compared to 11% across all mainstream Government schools. *Mathematics* 

94% of pupils at FCJ were assessed as Early Learning Goal (ELG) achieved within their year group at the end of Reception compared to 79% across all mainstream Government schools. 30% were exceeding ELG for Number and 30% for Space Shape and Measure (SSM), compared to 18% for Number and 13% for SSM across all mainstream Government schools.
